Qualification of Applicants

1. Hold a Bachelor's (or equivalent) degree in dentistry or relevant fields, with honor class or with GPA at least 3.25. (Scheme 2.2)
2. Hold a Master's (or equivalent) degree in dentistry or relevant fields. (Scheme 1.1 and Scheme 2.1)
3. Minimum English proficiency score: CU-TEP 67, TOEFL 525 (Paper-based) / 197 (Computer-based) / 71 (Internet-based) or IELTS 5.5. taken within 2 years. **The examination scores must not exceed more than 2 years since the report date until the announcement of exam results. The test scores must be valid for at least 2 months in order to be approved by the Faculty Executive Committee.** (Applicants with CU-TEP score of at least 45 or TOEFL score of at least 450 or IELTS score 4.0 of at least 3 may be admitted to the program but they have to meet the language proficiency requirement of the graduate school before Dissertation Examination.)
4. The Program Administrative Committee has approved the eligible for application.
